RESOLUTION NO. 2021 - 03

To Adopt Budget and Request the City Council to Levy the Fee for 2022

WHEREAS, pursuant to Act 151 of the 2007 Regular Session of the Louisiana State Legislature, codified at La.R.S. 33:9091.11 (as amended by the Amendment, as defined below, the "Act"), The Hurstville Security and Neighborhood Improvement District, (hereinafter referred to as "District") a security and improvement district of the state of Louisiana, was created; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the aforesaid Act, the affairs of the District is managed by a Board of Commissioners consisting of nine members (the "Board"); and

WHEREAS, the aforesaid Act authorized the New Orleans City Council to impose and collect a fee on each parcel of ground located within the district subject to the question of imposition of such fee being approved by a majority of registered voters of the District voting at an election for that purpose; and

WHEREAS, the imposition of a fee was approved by the registered voters of the District;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Act 49 of the 2013 Regular Session of the Louisiana State Legislature (the "Amendment"), the District's authority to impose and collect a fee was extended until December 31, 2022, subject to approval by the registered voters residing in the District; and

WHEREAS, the registered voters residing in the District approved a continuation of the authority of the District to levy the authorized annual fee which, commencing January 1, 2015 is not to exceed a maximum per year of five hundred fifty dollars (\$550.00) plus twenty-five dollars (\$25) per year for each calendar year after 2015; and

WHEREAS, the Act authorizes the amount of the fee to be as requested by a duly adopted resolution of the Board, subject to the foregoing limitation; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Act, the Board is required to adopt for the District an annual budget and plan in accordance with applicable law, including the Louisiana Local Government Budget Act, La. R.S. 39:1301 et seq.; and

WHEREAS, the Board desires that the Council of the City of New Orleans levy and collect a parcel fee of \$530 on each improved taxable parcel of real property within the District, and add such fee to the property bills to be issued by the City of New Orleans to the owners of the property within the District that is subject to the fee for the tax year commencing 2022;

WHEREAS notice for public hearing was duly posted and said public hearing was held on September 20, 2021 in conjunction with the Meeting of the Board of Commissioners; and

WHEREAS the Board of Commissioners have duly adopted a Plan for 2022; now, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE HURSTVILLE SECURITY AND NEIGHBORHOOD IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT THAT the following budget of revenue and expenditures for 2022 is adopted and the City Council of New Orleans is hereby requested to levy the fee of \$530 for the year 2022 for the purposes permitted in the Act:

1. Budget

The District estimates net receipts on 763 taxable parcels of property for the tax year 2022 at \$530 per parcel, considering a 99% collectible rate and less city fees, to be \$396,343. Therefore, the budget for the District for the 2022 calendar year is as follows:


